Plan Section	Section Title	Assessment Guideline	Score
Part A	Employment	Overall percentage of labour hours/FTE jobs in South Australia (Add data from Part A & Part C then apply scoring criteria)	>90% = 35 >80% but ≤90% = 25 >70% but ≤80% = 20 >60% but ≤70% = 15 >50% but ≤60% = 10 ≤50% = 0
Part B	Capital Expenditure:	Demonstrates significant investment in the State that has the potential to provide temporary or ongoing economic benefit to the State	Excellent = 3 Acceptable/good = 2 Marginal = 1 Unacceptable = 0
Part C	Supply Inputs	Percentage of supply inputs (based on value) that are sourced from (or have the potential to be sourced from) South Australia. If Yes is ticked to completing contract in-house, score will be equivalent to the Part A score. i.e. >90% SA labour = 7, 66% SA labour = 3	>90% = 7 >80% but ≤90% = 6 >70% but ≤80% = 4 >60% but ≤70% = 3 >50% but ≤60% = 2 ≤50% = 0
Part D	Procurement Practices	Demonstrates a procurement process consistent with the IPP	Excellent = 5 Acceptable/good = 3 Marginal = 1 Unacceptable = 0

Score	Scoring guidance
3 - Excellent	Response demonstrates that all requirements have been met in full and at least some of the requirements will be exceeded.
2 - Acceptable/Good	Response demonstrates that most major and minor requirements have been met.
1 - Marginal	Response demonstrates that only minor requirements have been met.
0 - Unacceptable	Response fails to demonstrate that any requirements have been met.
